Part Two: *Prayer's effect on our God awareness (11:5-13)*

I. Prayer affects our Self-Awareness: (11:1-4)

– The Lord's Prayer helps us to empty our hands so that we are able to receive God's grace. (11:1-4)

II. Prayer affects our God-Awareness: (11:5-12)

A. Pray for others knowing that God will honor your persistence and boldness (5-8)

B. Pray for personal needs knowing that God will provide an answer (9-10)

1. Ask and you will receive

2. Seek and you will find

3. Knock and the door will be opened.

C. Pray knowing that God will neither trick or endanger you with His answer. (11-12)

III. The focus of all three prayers is salvation ... a personal relationship with God. (13)

A. The good gift from God is the Holy Spirit.

B. The Holy Spirit is given at the moment we place our faith in Jesus Christ.

IV. Application:

A. Pray for the salvation of others with persistence and boldness.

B. Take comfort that everyone who seeks God will find Him.

C. Be encouraged that God will never trick or endanger those who call on Him.

⁵ Then he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend, and he goes to him at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread,'⁶ because a friend of mine on a journey has come to me, and I have nothing to set before him.'

⁷ "Then the one inside answers, 'Don't bother me. The door is already locked, and my children are with me in bed.
