Three Lies We Tell God

Luke 22:47-53

I. I love you ... (47-48)

A. We say this to God ... but our actions reveal our lack of love.

B. We say this to one another ... but our actions reveal our lack of love.

II. You don't love me ... (49-51)

A. We say this to God ... but His actions reveal His genuine love.

B. We say this to one another ... but their actions should reveal their genuine love.

III. I need to take control ... (52-53)

A. We say this to God ... thinking we actually know best.

B. We say this to one another ... thinking we are better than them.

IV. Application:

A. Our love for God is made evident through our actions which reveal the true desire of our heart.

B. No matter what we do ... God will always act toward us with love.

C. We need to yield to the Spirit's control ... not allowing darkness to reign in our life.
